Call to Reunion 2012

Greetings shipmates of **USS NORFOLK DL-1, USS MITSCHER DL-2 / DDG-35,
USS JOHN S. MCCAIN DL-3 / DDG-36, USS WILLIS A. LEE DL-4, & USS WILKINSON DL-5.**

The Destroyer Leader Association invites all shipmates who served on any of the above ships at any time to attend the next reunion to be held in Galveston, Texas from 10 to 13 September 2012. A Hospitality Room will be provided for you to socialize with your shipmates and peruse photos, cruise books, or other memorabilia from your ship. This is the place to meet your old shipmates, make new friends, and retell all those sea stories! Your Reunion Planner has arranged two tours of many of the interesting attractions in the Galveston area.

Note that you do NOT have to be a dues paying member of the Destroyer Leader Association, Inc., to attend the reunion. ALL former shipmates are invited to the reunion activities. However, you MUST be a dues paying member in order to attend the Annual Business Meeting of the DL Association to be held in the hotel on Wednesday morning.

HILTON GALVESTON ISLAND RESORT

The host hotel for the 2012 reunion is the Hilton Galveston Island Resort, 5400 Seawall Blvd, Galveston, TX 77551. This resort hotel is located across the street from the beach on the Gulf of Mexico. Hotel room reservations must be made by you directly with the hotel by calling the **Reservations Department @ 1-877-425-4753 (toll free)**. You must ask for the Destroyer Leader Association Group rate of **\$84.00 plus taxes**. (Pricing with current tax is \$96.60, single or double.) These DL room rates will also apply three days before or after the reunion. You will be responsible for your room, tax and incidental charges. All charges must be paid to the hotel at check-out. Please be advised that all room cancellations must be received by the hotel's Reservations Department 48 hours prior to day of arrival for a full refund, after which time no refund will be granted. **A block of 60 rooms is being held until 5:00 pm EDT Tuesday August 9th, 2012, after which any unsold rooms will be released to the public and the group rate will no longer be available.** (You must make your hotel reservation by August 9th, 2012 to receive the heavily discounted DLA rate.). The Association is NOT handling any room reservations. Our room block is for "Run of House" rooms. Requests for specific room types may be made at the time of reservation; however, requests such as bed type, view, and/or smoking preferences are based upon availability at time of check-in and are not guaranteed. If you need assistance, you may call the hotel @ (409) 740-8602. The Hotel will provide complimentary parking, including unoccupied RV's. There is Valet Parking for a fee. Room rate does not include a breakfast in the hotel's restaurant (Palm Court). The only food and beverage included in the room rate is morning coffee in the lobby. IHOP, McDonalds, and other restaurants are located nearby.

Early Departure Fee: In the event that a guest who has a room reservation checks out prior to the guest's reserved checkout date, an early departure fee of one night's room and tax may be charged to that guest's individual account. Guests wishing to avoid this fee must advise the hotel at or before check-in of any change in the scheduled length of stay. **See http://www.hilton.com/en/hi/groups/personalized/G/GLSGIHF-DLA-20120908/index.html?WT.mc_id=POG.** Transportation to/from Houston's airports is NOT PROVIDED by the hotel. The nearest airport is William P. Hobby, and shuttle or limousine service is available at the airport for a fee, currently \$36.00 one way per person.

They can take advantage of the special reduced hotel rates, enjoy the beach/surf, and go sightseeing with you. Photos, scrapbooks, and verbal telling of sea stories would let them know what your Navy life was like. This is an excellent opportunity to pass on your military/patriotic service to our great country. Your family will develop a deeper appreciation of what you have done for them and your country.

ACTIVITIES

GENERAL

Following are descriptions of the many activities throughout the 2012 Reunion, depending upon minimums being met. All reunion activities are optional - you select which ones in which you want to join. The Hospitality Room will be open throughout most of the reunion. Tour prices are based on a minimum of 35 paid passengers per tour as noted in the Tour description. Each tour package price includes a Motor Coach, admissions as noted, meals as listed, and taxes. Boarding times of the coaches will be 15 minutes prior to listed departure times at the front of the Hilton Galveston Island Hotel lobby. Gratuities for the step-on tour guide and driver are not included. First seat behind the driver is reserved for tour guide on Tour 2M.

A "Welcome Aboard" Team will be at the Reunion Registration table in the Hospitality Room with a package in your name. This package will contain your name tag, a program, meal tickets and tour tickets for your selected activities, welcome letters, and other information. The "Ship's Store", selling caps, shirts, and other memorabilia will be open during most Hospitality Room hours. A "2012 Reunion Memories Book" may be ordered directly from the photographer on the night couples/portraits are taken. If you want a Memory Book but are not attending the reunion, please contact your Ship Coordinator prior to the reunion. The photographer will be from Picture Day Photography of Mansfield, Ohio.

REUNION REGISTRATION INFORMATION

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REGISTRATION

The Welcome Aboard and Registration Table, located in the Hospitality Room, is where you pick up your reunion envelope, information, meal tickets, brochures, name tags, etc. **Walk-ins may register here, but meal, event and tour tickets will not be available after August 8th or for walk-ins. This is due to contractual agreements with the hotel and tour company. Registration by mail will not be accepted after August 8th.** Anyone registering after August 8th is eligible to attend the reunion Hospitality Room, Board meeting, lecture, photo session, ladies fashion show, and business meeting only, as tickets for other events WILL NOT be available.

Absolutely no exceptions!

BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING: Monday 2000 - 2200

A brief meeting of the Officers and Directors will be held in Crystal C Ballroom. However, any DL Association member may attend as an observer and is invited to do so. If you do plan to attend, please indicate this on the Registration Form so that a room sufficiently large enough to accommodate meeting attendees may be requested of the hotel.

HILTON HOSTED WELCOME RECEPTION: Monday 1700 – 1800 w/Cash Bar

This is where the Reunion officially begins! Located in Crystal Ballroom, the reception is hosted by The Hilton Galveston Island Resort. Hilton's management team will provide complimentary beer, wine, and cheese for those guests staying at the hotel. DLA President Larry Rossi will also welcome attendees. You **MUST BE STAYING** at the hotel and **MUST LIST** on the Registration Form that you are attending this function; otherwise sufficient quantities of food may not be available. The snacks provided are **not** intended to be your evening meal. This is **NOT** a sit-down affair; you are encouraged to circulate to meet and greet your shipmates. This is a fun evening in a relaxed and casual atmosphere. *(Dinner is on your own this evening. Enjoy one of the fine restaurants along Galveston's Gulf Coast.)*

BUFFET DINNER: Tuesday 1800 w/Cash Bar

This evening's dinner will be served buffet style in the Crystal Ballroom of the hotel's Ballroom. Meal tickets are required. After the President's welcoming remarks, first time attendees will be asked to introduce themselves so everyone will be acquainted. Dress is casual.

HOSPITALITY ROOM: Sunday thru Wednesday

The Hospitality Room will be located in the hotel's Tower Ballroom. This is your "home away from home" during the reunion. It is the perfect place to greet old friends you haven't seen in years, meet shipmates you didn't know, and meet people who served at a different time but share your ship's heritage. Bring any memorabilia from your Navy days for display here. The Hospitality Room will be open most of the day for those not going on tours "if there are volunteers to stand watch during the tours", otherwise it will close. Call the reunion planner (Walter Alexander., CMRP, on 540 – 353 – 5826) to volunteer. Room will be closed during the Welcome Reception, Buffet and Banquet. **Food and beverage items provided in the Hospitality Room may not be taken from the room due to hotel contractual agreements.** No "open foods or drinks" (such as bowls of chips, chip dips, cheese, or 2-liter soft drink bottles) are allowed due to health reasons. Private alcoholic beverages are not permitted in the Hospitality Room at any time for both legal and liability reasons. (Adult beverages may be purchased from the hotel's bar near the Lobby.) Anyone bringing an item to donate for the auction is requested to place it in the Hospitality Room upon arrival at the reunion. The auction will be held Tuesday night after the buffet dinner. This is the primary fund raiser for the DLA.

LADIES FASHION SHOW: Wednesday 0900 - 1030

A complimentary Hat & Fashion Show for "ladies only" in the Hospitality Room will be presented by Peggy Wardell, proprietor of Victorian Corner in Galveston. Audience participation is encouraged!

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MEN'S BUSINESS MEETING: Wednesday 0900 - 1100

The annual membership Business Meeting of the DLA will be held in the Crystal C Ballroom. Only DLA dues paying members-in-good standing will be admitted. Please have your current membership card or have your name checked against a roster by a Master-At-Arms at the door. This important meeting will elect Board members/Officers for the coming years and other matters of Association business, such as the location of future reunions. There will be an opportunity to meet with your Ship Coordinator at the conclusion of DLA business. Your Ship Coordinator is your ship's representative on the Board of Directors.

NAVAL HISTORY LECTURE: Wednesday 1330 – 1430

Captain John Rodgaard (USN, Ret.) of Virginia will give a presentation on the evolution of the destroyer leader as a sub-category of the destroyer type ship. He had a 41 year career in the Navy and is a recognized naval historian.

PHOTO SHOOT – COUPLES & INDIVIDUALS: Wednesday 1530 - 1800

Every reunion attendee is encouraged and requested to have a portrait photo taken as a couple or an individual for the Reunion Memories Book. The photo room will be located in the Pre-Function Area of Crystal Ballroom. A professional photographer from Picture Day Photography of Mansfield, Ohio will be on hand to take the photos and later provide the Reunion Memories Book. Please fill out the Photo Information Card found in your Welcome Aboard Packet prior to coming for your portrait. Proofs will be mailed to you by Picture Day. You are given an opportunity to purchase a portrait, but you are not obligated to make any purchase. Purchasing a Memories Book is also optional, but your photo in the book would provide a memory to those attending and who do purchase the yearbook. Enjoy your last night in a more formal setting. Coat and tie recommended for the gentlemen and corresponding dress for the ladies. Gentlemen are encouraged to wear their ribbons, medals, or mini-medals on their suit jacket. If you can still wear your uniform, please do so. Upon arrival at the reunion, see your Ship Coordinator in the Hospitality Room for Table Sign-up sheets to reserve a banquet table so you may sit with your shipmates or your friends. The doors will open for seating at 1900. **Please wait until after the Invocation before beginning to dine.** Installation of Officers will follow dinner. All ships will get underway for their homeports. Have a safe journey home and we'll see you next year at the 2013 DLA reunion in Warwick, Rhode Island.

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NAME TAGS

Members attending the reunion use permanent blue plastic laminated name tags. The name tag includes the attendee (or guest) name, rate, years aboard, ship name and hull number. Each year, a new reunion city tag (with year date) is added to the name tag. The reunion city tag (and metal rings for attaching to name tag) is included in the Registration Fee. Bring your previously issued name tag, and the city tag can be added at the Ship's Store when you pick up your Registration envelope.

If you are a first time attendee or have misplaced your name tag, a new permanent name tag as described above can be provided. Please fill out the information on the Registration Form for yourself and guest and include the price of the name tag with your Registration Payment. (If you do not need or desire a permanent name tag, do not include the price of the name tag in your payment.) Also, if you need a city tag for a previous reunion attended, that may also be ordered.

NOTE: The laminated nametags are fastened to your clothing with a magnetic device. If you have a Pacemaker, you should not use the magnet fastener. Please indicate on the Registration Form that you need a clutch pin attachment rather than magnets.

CANCELLATIONS / REFUNDS

The DL Association must pay the motor coach company and tour venues by August 9th, 2012. **THE CANCELLATION POLICY IS THAT NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED AFTER THIS TIME EXCEPT IN EXTREME EMERGENCY (WEATHER, DEATH, ETC. SUCH REFUNDS WILL BE HANDLED ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS AS REVIEWED BY THE DLA BOARD OF DIRECTORS.) ANY PARTICIPANT WHO DOES NOT SHOW FOR THEIR TOUR BECAUSE THEY FORGOT, OVERSLEPT, CHANGED THEIR MIND, ETC. WILL NOT RECEIVE A REFUND.** The minimum for any tour to run is 35 paid passengers as noted with the tour description. If less than 35 sign up for a tour, then your money will be refunded after the reunion.

No refunds for meals will be made after August 8th, 2012 as final guaranteed numbers must be given to the hotel and paid as of that date. Same cancellation policy applies for meals as for tours above.

If you must cancel your trip to the reunion, remember **YOU** must:

- (1) Call the hotel to cancel your room, and **YOU** must:
- (2) Call 330-823-8230 as soon as you know but (before August 9th) so that we may modify our hotel/activities count. We will gladly send you a refund for any activity that has not already been paid to the hotel or tour company.

Anyone attending the Reunion but NOT staying at the host Hilton Galveston Island Resort is required to pay an additional Hotel User Fee/Assessment of \$30.00 to cover meeting & banquet room rental, setup & cleaning, bartender fees, etc. This fee does not apply to those staying in a room at the Hilton Galveston Island Resort, nor member's guests. See Registration Form.

All Reunion Registrations with full payment must be received by August 8th.

Registrations will NOT be accepted by mail or phone after August 8th.

Instead, they must be brought to the hotel for Late Registration from August 9th to September 9th. All Tours, Tuesday Buffet, and Wednesday Banquet are for Pre-registered only.

Tickets for these events will not be available after August 8th.

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TOURS



Galveston Limousine Service motor coach is used.

All tours begin loading at the front of the hotel fifteen (15) minutes before departure time listed in the Plan Of the Day. Please board promptly at all venues so that on-time departures may be made. Gratuities for driver and step-on guide ARE NOT INCLUDED. Participating on any tour is optional. Note that ALL tours require some walking and some parts of a tour may not be ADA compatible, such as the ship, submarine, and mansions. For the Mariner's Day Tour, you are off the motor coach for almost the entire time and considerable walking is required. Motor coaches have a luggage compartment for carrying wheel chairs, but a lift is not available. On Tours 2M & 3T, you must be able to negotiate stairs at some venues. Proper footwear required. No flip flops please, and all sandals must have straps. High heels are not recommended. ALL TOURS REQUIRE WALKING TO VISIT THE ATTRACTIONS. Min 35, max 90 each tour.

Sunday, Tour #1S (NASA) for Early Arrivals, 0845 - 1600: (\$43.00)

Board your Galveston Limousine Service (GLS) motor coach beginning at 0845 for a 0900 departure to the NASA Space Center Houston. Upon arrival at 1000, it is suggestion you first ride the tram tour and then visit other exhibits on your own. **This tour includes a meal ticket for lunch at "Launch Foods" in the Zero-G Dinner.** Your Bus Monitor will inform you the time of departure from the Center.

Monday, Tour #2M, (Galveston Island) 0830 - 1630: (\$49.00)

Board your GLS motor coach beginning at 0830 for a 0845 departure to the Lone Star Flight Museum. Then continue to Moody Gardens for a visit to the Rainforest Pyramid – a 10-story glass pyramid with beautiful plants, flowers, orchids, free roaming monkeys, sloths, free flight birds, and also a butterfly enclosure. **Next you will travel to Casey's Restaurant for lunch (NOT included in tour price.)** You will have a choice of one of three entrée's (Blackened Tilapia \$11.99, Casey's Classic Burger \$10.99, or 7 Fried Premium Gulf Shrimp \$11.99), and each includes salad, entrée, side, and coffee/tea from a special senior's menu. Please indicate your entrée choices on the Registration Form so the restaurant will have sufficient quantities available. Your server will give you your food check (with tax and service charge added) to pay prior to departing. A step-on tour guide will join you as you re-board your motor coach for a narrated 2 - hour windshield tour of Galveston Island including Seawall, Tree Sculptures, Historic Downtown Strand Seaport District, the Broadway Beauties, etc. Depending on the number of passengers, your coach will then take you to either the 1895 Moody Mansion or the 1892 Gresham's Mansion (Bishop's Palace) for a docent's guided tour of one historic home. Please check with your Bus Monitor for the time of departure at each venue.

Tuesday, Tour #3T, (Mariner's Day 0845 - 1530: (\$48.00)

Board your GLS motor coach beginning at 0845 for a 0900 departure. Ride to the American Undersea Warfare Center at Seawolf Park to visit USS *Stewart* DE-244 (one of only two DE's remaining from WWII) and USS *Cavalla* SSK-244 (on her maiden patrol, she sank the 30,000 ton aircraft carrier *Shokaku*.) The annual DLA Memorial Service will be held outdoors at the plaza located between the ship and boat. You will then have time to go aboard either of these World War Two vessels for self-guided tours and to visit the gift shop. **Lunch at Fisherman's Wharf Restaurant at downtown's Harborside is included in the price of the tour.** Lunch includes coffee, tea or soda with your entrée. Please indicate your choice of Cesar Salad w/Chicken, Popcorn Shrimp w/French fries, 2 pieces of Catfish w/French fries, or a Chicken Sandwich w/French fries. After lunch, walk to the nearby Texas Seaport Museum to see a video on the restoration of 1877 Tall Ship *Elissa* (which will be away at dry dock during our visit) and browse thru the museum's displays. Then walk past monuments honoring the Republic of Texas Navy and the WWII Merchant Marine & U.S. Navy Armed Guard as you make your way to the *Ocean Star* Off-Shore Drilling Rig Museum about a block away for a self-guided tour. Note that drawbridge operation may affect the timing of this tour, so please check with your Bus Monitor for the time of departure from Seawolf Park and *Ocean Star* museum.

TOUR ON YOUR OWN – There are many other attractions for you to explore on your own: Schlitterbahn Water Park, Railroad Museum, Aquarium Pyramid, Harbor Cruise Tour, 1897 Opera House, etc. So much to do with so little time!

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RV PARK INFORMATION

If you plan to stay in your RV while in Galveston, the nearest RV Park is located a few miles west of the Hilton Hotel. **Dellanera RV Park**, located on FM 3005 at 7 Mile Road, offers visitors a beachfront home-away-from-home on the Gulf of Mexico. The park provides 1,000 feet of sandy beach with 63 full RV hook-ups and day parking. Call regarding reservations as the park may run full during summer time.
